Downers Grove, IL—On August 18, 2006, InterVarsity Press broke ground on a 13,400-square-foot warehouse expansion located on the east side of the existing distribution center. The new space will accommodate InterVarsity Press's growth needs and better serve our customers.

The first phase of the construction process involved breaking ground for the new warehouse and has already allotted InterVarsity Press additional parking spaces. Completion of this phase is estimated for December 2006. The second phase of the project will begin after the new year and involves reconfiguring the existing warehouse and interior space.
