InterVarsity Press to Publish New Book by Webber

June 6, 2007--InterVarsity Press announces the publication of a new book by the late theologian Robert Webber. In *Who Gets to Narrate the World? Contending for the Christian Story in an Age of Rivals* Webber (author of *Ancient-Future Faith* [Baker], *The Divine Embrace* [Baker] and *The Younger Evangelicals* [Baker]) voices his deep concern that American evangelicals have lost sight of the Christian story in their accommodation to mainstream culture. In response, Webber calls Christians to recognize and confront both the external and internal challenges facing them in today's world.

Editor Joel Scandrett calls Webber "a principal catalyst in American evangelicalism's recovery of its ancient catholic Christian heritage, and a major proponent of approaches to worship grounded in that 'great tradition.'" Says Scandrett, "This book will both challenge and assist Christians to reclaim the unique story which God has given us to proclaim and to live: the Christian story."

Who Gets to Narrate the World? (144 pages, paper, 978-0-8308-3481-5, \$15.00) is scheduled to be published in May 2008.
