- Michael Card has released over 20 recordings, and has authored or co-authored 14 books over his 20-year career. Michael has sold over 400,000 books as an author and has been published in a medical journal. He has sold over 4 million collectively of his works.
- Michael has 19 Number 1 hits to his credit. But, he has said, "Music is secondary to me. I am a teacher." Card teaches a Bible study once a week in Franklin, Tennessee. He has also taught physics and astronomy classes before.
- Card sometimes spends years researching and writing for an album and has covered major theological subjects ranging from the birth, death and resurrection of Christ, his crucifixion, Psalms and the Word. His best-selling record was of lullabies, an album that took just months to write and record.
- Michael plays a variety of instruments, from piano to guitar. At one time, he studied banjo under Earl Scruggs.
- "El Shaddai" received the honor of being named one of the top 365 songs of the Century by RIAA, but Michael thinks "Emmanuel" is the best song he has ever written.
- Michael averages about 60 concert dates a year. He prefers riding the tour bus over flying to a concert date.
