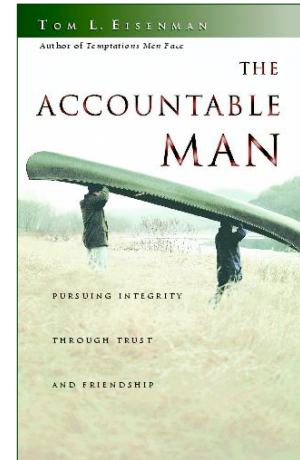


Sometimes Good Men Make Bad Choices.
