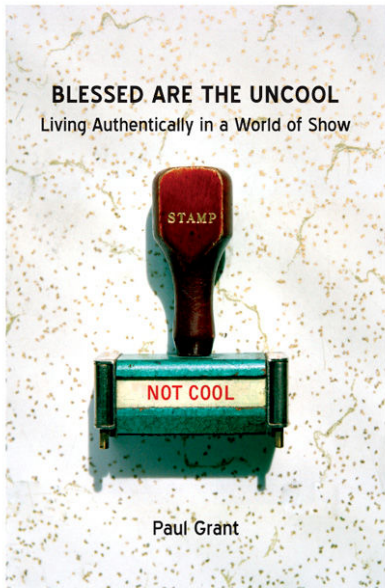




Are you cool? Paul Grant doesn't want you to be . . .
