

Discussion Questions for *Speaking of Jesus*

1. In what ways can you grow in your outreach efforts?
2. What links went together in God's chain to bring you to Christ?
3. In what ways is equipping more than memorizing a gospel outline? Write out, in your own words, the core tenets of the gospel.
4. What steps do you need to take—with your mind, heart or feet—to make a divine appointment happen?
5. How did Jesus model humility in his interaction with the woman at the well?
6. What social barriers did Christ cross when he spoke to the Samaritan woman? What consequences do you think he risked?
7. What social barriers face you? What changes need to happen so you can cross those barriers?
8. Reread 2 Corinthians 3:4-6. Where does Paul say our confidence is from?
9. What things erode your evangelistic confidence? How might you be tempted to gain confidence apart from Christ?
10. How does biblical self-image help us share our faith?
11. When Jesus responded to the woman at the well, how did he speak in her language? How did he model integrity? How did he listen to the Spirit?
12. In what ways was the woman at the well an odd choice for Jesus' first evangelist? What was her chief qualification? How does that give us hope for our own efforts in evangelism?
13. Are there parts of the gospel message you are tempted to skip or modify? How might diplomacy help?
14. What holds you back from asking people to step into faith in Christ?
