In 2017 five-year-old Julia traveled with her mother from Honduras to the United States. Her harrowing journey took her through Mexico in the cargo section of a tractor trailer. Then she was separated from her mother, who was held hostage by smugglers who exploited her physically and financially. At the United States border, Julia was put in detention as an unaccompanied minor.

A Spanish-speaking former missionary, Gena Thomas became Julia's foster mother and witnessed firsthand the ways migrant children experience trauma. Weaving together the stories of birth mother and foster mother, this book shows the human face of the immigrant and refugee, the challenges of the immigration and foster care systems, and the tenacious power of motherly love.



GENA THOMAS is the instructional design specialist on staff with the Chalmers Center in Lookout Mountain, Georgia, working to alleviate poverty by equipping churches to empower the poor.
