Keith D. Meyer (D.Min., M.Div.) has served three churches as senior pastor and was the executive pastor at Church of the Open Door. He is an adjunct professor at Denver Seminary and a senior teaching fellow with the Renovaré Spiritual Formation Institute. Meyer is a speaker, teacher and retreat leader through his organization, Becoming the Change Ministries.
