
Infiltrating Hell

Daniel Walker is an undercover investigator who has worked for both law enforcement and nonprofit organizations. In *God in a Brothel*, he tells the story of how he infiltrated the multibillion dollar global sex industry in order to liberate women and children from slavery.

Walker provides vivid firsthand accounts of rescue as he traces his steps through a diffuse criminal underground stretching from Southeast Asia to Las Vegas, Nevada.

But you can't descend into hell without facing some degree of agony, and Walker is candid about the great personal cost of his work. He hopes, in fact, that tomorrow's workers will draw important lessons from his experience:

"Had I glimpsed just a little of the suffering I would witness and the heartbreak I would endure, I would have fled in the other direction. . . . But I could not foresee any of these things. . . . And many years later, with tears in my eyes, I remembered my decision to follow this God no matter what the cost."



A Portrait of Rescue



Her straight black hair was pulled back in a ponytail from her face. She was beautiful, with striking eyes and a clear complexion. She was alone. She was confused. She was scared.

Leading her from the darkness of her tiny hovel into the bright sunlight, safety and freedom, I felt overwhelmed by a sense of gratitude, joy and protectiveness. . . . As if she were my own little sister, I walked beside her. . . .

After placing her inside one of the police vehicles, the female social workers on our team quietly communicated to her that she was not in any trouble but rather that she was forever liberated from the brothel and from her work there.
