Missional Spirituality to the Rescue

More than 80 percent of churches in North America have plateaued or are in decline because they are failing to adapt with the changing culture. The increase in common-law living, divorce, gay relationships, blended families, single-parent families and Internet dating are but a few of the relational realities that need to be addressed today. Meanwhile, addictions, depression, suicide, bullying, pornography and profound loneliness—among other things—signal that the culture is not okay.

Yet at the same time, an interest in Jesus and “spirituality” persists among many, even if those same folks disrespect Christians and don’t want church. So it is a pivotal—if incredibly challenging—time for those who wish to share their faith in a compelling way with a hurting world.

Roger Helland and Leonard Hjalmarsen contend that what believers need at this critical moment is a missional spirituality, “a spirituality that forms and feeds mission.” In their new book, these seasoned leaders offer the church a winsome path forward as they answer questions like:

What are some examples of missional spirituality from the past?

What can pastors do to equip their congregations to live out a missional spirituality?
