*Walton Image Supply: This is a low-cost option for images (about \$20 each) of biblical and archeological sites or ancient artifacts and artwork, particularly of European (Roman, Greek and Jewish) background. You can create a list of particular images you want for the manuscript (e.g., Masada, statue of Mars) or you can send the manuscript to Kim Walton and for an additional fee she will select potential images from her collection. She also has access to the Baker Photo Archive, though those are a bit more expensive, about \$75 each. She is aware that world rights for print and electronic in all languages and all editions are needed, though it is still important to specify that.

After you have selected images from these sites, please provide your editor with the following information (see example below): image number,* image description** and credit information, as well as a sample copy of the desired image. Lightbox versions are sufficient for the image samples.
